

# Aloha Command Center 3.1 Highlighted Features

Aloha Command Center is a dynamic support tool bringing enhanced security and simplicity to the process of implementing, supporting and maintaining Aloha sites. Enhancement releases provide innovative, good-for-industry features that deliver product improvements for Command Center customers.

## Terminal Imaging

As part of our ongoing effort to increase productivity and reduce costs, Command Center now supports creating and restoring terminal images. An original set of images can be created from each terminal and those images can be updated on a periodic basis. Terminals can then be restored using these images to fix issues and minimize unneeded hardware replacements.

## File Manager Usability

Enhancements to File Manager have been implemented to make site support faster and easier. New enhancements incorporated into File Manager include:

- Visual indicators when a non-active site is selected.
- An Auto Load feature that will automatically load the selected path when changing from site to site in the Site Tree.
- A Reload feature that will quickly reload selected paths.
- User input path for faster navigation to locations not listed in the Load List directory.
- “RPTEXTORT” and “ESINST” have been added to the Load List directory.
- “View” now opens certain files in their default application, if available. This will allow users to save these files locally and print them locally as well.

## Unix Based VNC

A new Unix based version of VNC has been implemented in the CMC Data Center. According to initial customer feedback, this version is faster and more stable!

## Remote EDC Login

Similar to the current Remote AlohaMGR functionality, users will now be able to remotely log in to EDC with their CMC credentials.

## Additional CMC 3.1 Usability Enhancements

The following enhancements have also been added to CMC v3.1 to increase usability.

- Searches in the Site Tree resume from the top once the bottom is reached.
- Various new reports have been added.
- The ENTER key is now a shortcut to File Manager, when applicable (similar to the double-click on Alerts and Deployments which is a shortcut to Store Manager).
- A warning message has been added to Deploy Manager when the install date of a deployment is prior to the current date.
